RE: Election Procedures

Enclosed you will find a document titled "Election Procedures for Voting for NACO Officers." It details the pre-election process and the election day process.

Also enclosed is the Voter Confirmation form for your county. It is of utmost importance that you complete and return the voter confirmation form to the NACO Office by Friday, December 8, 2023. **Absence of the returned confirmation form will only allow the county board chair to cast the ballot in person for a county.**

In addition, I would strongly suggest that you designate an alternate just in case the county board chair or the person initially selected to cast the ballot for the county is unable to attend the business meeting.

Election Procedures for Voting for NACO Officers 2023 Election

Pre-Election Process

- 1.) An email was sent on September 11, 2023 from the NACO Executive Director to County Board Chairs, County Clerks and the President of the NACO Northeast District with information regarding the nomination of candidates for the incoming Secretary-Treasurer position on the NACO Board in the Northeast district rotation that can nominate names for the position of NACO Secretary-Treasurer.
- 2.) The letter enclosed in this mailing from the NACO Executive Director to each County Board Chair member 30 days prior to election indicates that as per bylaws Article II Section 2. "Each voting member shall be entitled to one-vote on each matter submitted to a vote of the members. Each vote shall be cast by the Chairperson of the County Board of Commissioners or Supervisors or their designee. There shall be no votes cast by proxy."
- 3.) The form enclosed in this mailing from the NACO Executive Director will also accompany the letter, providing instructions for completion. If the Chairperson of the County Board of Commissioners or Supervisors plans to be in attendance, they should identify themselves as the person casting the ballot and they should identify a designee in the event the Chairperson of the County Board of Commissioners or Supervisors is unavailable to cast the ballot for their county.

This form must be returned to the NACO office by the Friday preceding the election at the annual conference. **Absence of the returned confirmation form will only allow the county board chair to cast the ballot in person for a county.**

- 4.) If a candidate has an intention to run for the position of NACO Secretary – Treasurer and they notify the NACO office in writing 10 days in advance of the conference, then their name will be included on a pre-printed ballot. The ballot will also include a line for write in candidates and nominations from the floor.
- 5.) The NACO President will appoint a nominating committee to present a list of candidates and a counting committee to count the ballots during the annual business meeting.

Election Day Process

- 1.) During the Business meeting, County Board Chair or designee will be asked to come forward and sign the voting register and cast the ballot.
- 2.) The initial ballot for officer positions will contain the current officers that will be nominated to advance to the next higher office, with a line for write-ins to be provided for any nominations from the floor.
- 3.) In the event that during the initial balloting, one candidate does not receive a majority of the votes (50% of eligible votes), then a second election will take place with the top 2 vote getters from the previous election advancing. In the event of a tie vote for the 2nd and 3rd positions, an election will be held to break the tie and then the top vote getter of that election will advance to run off against the initial leading candidate. The runoff elections will be conducted with an official ballot containing only 1 line for a write in candidate.
- 4.) The same rules apply as to who can cast a vote as in item 1.
- 5.) The current NACO President will preside over the election.

The attached **YEAR-END CERTIFICATION OF COUNTY HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT** and **SIGNING RESOLUTION**, together with a copy of the **DOCUMENTATION OF THE COUNTY HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT(S) APPOINTMENT(S) for CALENDAR YEAR 2023**, is the basis for determining the calendar year 2023 Incentive Payment. **Please complete and return the following to the NDOT by December 31, 2023:**

- **Signing Resolution** (Page 1): The original Signing Resolution, authorizing the signing of the Year-End Certification(s) by the County Board Chairperson.
- **Year End Certification of County Highway Superintendent** (Page 2): If more than one individual or the County Board provided highway superintending services **during Calendar Year 2023**, document each successive appointed county highway superintendent and/or period without an appointed county highway superintendent using a separate Year-End Certification form. For any period of time your county did not have an appointed Highway Superintendent, write "County Board" as the name of the "Superintendent." **Copy the form as needed.**

Failure to complete and return: If a county had an appointed and Licensed County Highway Superintendent for all or part of Calendar Year 2023 and the county does not complete and return the above documentation to the NDOT **by December 31, 2023, the county will not receive an Incentive Payment for Calendar Year 2023.**

Payment: If your county qualifies, payment will be scheduled for February 2024. Reference Neb. Rev. Stat. §39-2505.

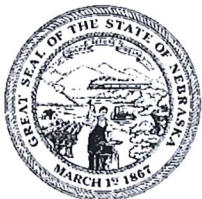

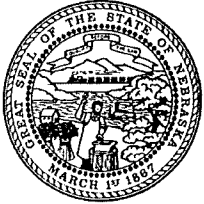

On 09/28/2023 your boiler/pressure vessel, NE16423, located at Cherry County Courthouse, 365 N Main St, Valentine, was inspected by Bruce Smiley with Hartford Steam Boiler. During that inspection, the below items were noted as not meeting the requirements of the Nebraska Boiler Inspection Act and **shall be corrected within 30 days from the date of this letter.**

Condition:

Refractory Damage - Repair or Replace - The refractory in this boiler is deteriorated, cracked, falling down onto the furnace, or missing. This is a serious safety concern.

Requirement:

Have the refractory in this boiler repaired or replaced by a boiler company to restore it to a safe condition and that is in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications. NBIC Part 2, 2.2.10.3

Condition:

Unit requires repairs as noted during inspection. It is suspected that one of the cast iron sections is warped from overheating. Recommend that cast iron sections be cleaned and evaluated by a licensed repair company. Boiler should then be repaired or replaced.

Requirement:

This unit requires repairs as noted above before it can be operated. If the necessary repairs are not going to be completed, the gas, water and electrical supplies shall be disconnected. If the outlet isolation valves do not fully isolate the unit, the valves shall be removed and the unit blanked off with the appropriate pressure rated blanks. If the unit is placed out-of-service, please note that on this letter.

Condition:

Burner - Repairs Needed

Requirement:

The burner assembly is in a condition that requires the burner to be repaired or replaced. Some items such as misalignment, tube misalignment, gasket wear, or diffuser ring issues may be the cause. Repair or replace the burner assembly to correct the following condition noted: ___ noted during inspection the burner has been removed____.

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
