FINAL NOTICE

On 09/28/2023 your boiler/pressure vessel, NE16423, located at Cherry County Courthouse, 365 N Main St, Valentine, was inspected by Bruce Smiley with Hartford Steam Boiler. During that inspection, the below items were noted as not meeting the requirements of the Nebraska Boiler Inspection Act.

This is your second and final violations notice.

All items identified below shall be corrected within 30 days from the date of this letter.

Condition:

Unit requires repairs as noted during inspection. It is suspected that one of the cast iron sections is warped from overheating. Recommend that cast iron sections be cleaned and evaluated by a licensed repair company. Boiler should then be repaired or replaced.

Requirement:

This unit requires repairs as noted above before it can be operated. If the necessary repairs are not going to be completed, the gas, water and electrical supplies shall be disconnected. If the outlet isolation vavles do not fully isolate the unit, the valves shall be removed and the unit blanked off with the appropriate pressure rated blanks. If the unit is placed out-of-service, please note that on this letter.

Condition:

Refractory Damage - Repair or Replace - The refractory in this boiler is deteriorated, cracked, falling down onto the furnace, or missing. This is a serious safety concern.

Requirement:

Have the refractory in this boiler repaired or replaced by a boiler company to restore it to a safe condition and that is in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications. NBIC Part 2, 2.2.10.3

Condition:

Burner - Repairs Needed

Requirement:

The burner assembly is in a condition that requires the burner to be repaired or replaced. Some items such as misalignment, tube misalignment, gasket wear, or diffuser ring issues may be the cause. Repair or replace the burner assembly to correct the following condition noted: ____noted during inspection the burner has been removed_____.
