

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MINUTES

February 12, 2019

The Cherry County Board of Commissioners met as a Board of Equalization on February 12, 2019 at 2:00 PM in the Cherry County Courthouse, as per notice in the Valentine Midland News, with the agenda being on file in the office of the County Clerk. The meeting was called to order at 2:00 PM by Chairman Storer. Roll call was taken. Present for the meeting were Cherry County Commissioners Tanya Storer, Martin DeNaeyer, and James Ward, and Cherry County Clerk Brittny Petersen.
