

NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that on **Tuesday the 12th day of May 2020**, a statewide Primary Election will be held in Nebraska.

The Cherry County Fairgrounds is no longer a polling place. All ballots will be delivered by non-forwardable mail to every registrant in Cherry County. Return envelopes, with postage included, will be provided. In accordance with §32-908, on Election Day, the Cherry County Clerk's Office will be open at 8:00 AM CT and close at 8:00 PM CT. If not returning by mail, ballots may be hand delivered to the Clerk's Office until 8:00 PM CT, the statutory close of the polls. Ballots will only be counted if they are received in the Clerk's Office by 8:00 PM CT, regardless of postmark date.

The Primary Election will be for the purpose of for electing some candidates to office, nominating candidates to the General Election on November 3rd, 2020, as well as voting on some special issues. Certain races below will only appear on the ballots of those Voters who reside in that district.
