May 31, 2016

The Cherry County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on May 31, 2016, as per notice in the Valentine Midland News, with the agenda being on file in the office of the County Clerk. Roll call was taken. Present at this meeting were County Commissioners: Jim Van Winkle, Mark Adamson, and Tanya Storer. Also present was Cherry County Clerk Tom Elliott. Martin DeNaeyer and Jim Ducey were also present for the meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM by Chairman Adamson. The Open Meetings Act Notice was announced. The minutes of the last regular meeting were read. Commissioner Adamson moved to approve minutes as read. Commissioner Van Winkle seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Adamsonaye. The motion carried.

May 10, 2016 Board of Corrections meeting minutes were read. Commissioner Adamson moved to approve minutes as read. Commissioner Storer seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. The motion carried.

The Board discussed the fact that the Comprehensive Development Plan for Cherry County was not available in a digital format for the general public. It was the consensus of the Board to make the plan available on the County's website.

The Board met with Geneie Andrews from GIS Workshop and Region 24 Emergency Management Director Doug Fox to discuss expanding Cherry County's online GIS Workshop site to include tabs for Emergency Management Services, Road, and Noxious Weed Departments. It was the consensus of the Board to research options for funding the new programs. No formal Board action was taken at this time.

Ed Knott and Gary Weaver addressed the Board regarding consolidation of phone carriers currently providing service to County offices. It was the consensus of the Board to allow further attention to the matter to determine what cost savings may be achieved. Mr. Knott also presented a new service contract to the Board.

Commissioner Adamson moved that Cherry County enter into a new service agreement with Applied Connective Technologies, LLC for a period of 12 months beginning June 1, 2016, with the addition of remote management and monitoring services. Commissioner Van Winkle seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. The motion carried.

Noxious Weed Superintendent Barb Small provided the Board with an update on her current weed control efforts. She discussed the increase in organic farming in the County and the need for developing some relevant protocol for controlling noxious weeds near those locations. She also addressed the need to update her computer technology and expressed her support for the new GIS proposal.

Commissioner Storer moved to amend the County's master contract with GIS Workshop with the expanded scope to include tabs for Emergency Management, Road Department, and Noxious Weed Department. Commissioner Adamson seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. Commissioner Storer-aye.

Lawrence Turner and Robert Shelbourn discussed concern for the spreading of a weed called Common Mullein in the County. They stated that the plant is unpalatable to livestock and can be resistant to chemical treatment due to the hairy surface of the leaves. It was the consensus of the Board to ask the Weed Superintendent to bring more public awareness to the problem through a variety of news media sources.

Dennis Hall discussed the deterioration of a County road in his area. He requested some additional surface material for portions of the road and the installation of a culvert near an intersection. It was the consensus of the Board to inspect the area and try to develop a long-term solution to the road where heavy rainfall causes the most damage.

Communications Director Gary Weaver discussed options for insuring some new equipment in the Courthouse, providing maintenance to generator back-up batteries, and the need to dispose of outdated radios currently being stored by the County Road Department. No formal Board action was required at this time.

At 3:00 PM, as advertised, the Board recessed from regular session to convene as a Board of Corrections.
