BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MINUTES Emergency Meeting May 27, 2020

The Cherry County Board of Commissioners met in Emergency session on May 27, 2020 at 3:00 PM in the Sheriff's Meeting Room of the Cherry County Courthouse. Notice of meeting was posted 24 hours in advance on the Cherry County website (co.cherry.ne.us), the Courthouse Doors, the Valentine Public Library, and the Valentine Post Office. The notice of the meeting was sent to media, KVSH & KSDZ radio, which had requested notification of such emergency meetings. The meeting was called to order at 3:00 PM by Chairman Storer. Roll call was taken. Present for the meeting were Cherry County Commissioners Tanya Storer, Martin DeNaeyer, James Ward, and Cherry County Clerk Brittny Petersen. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the location of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was acknowledged by Chairman Storer.

The purpose of the emergency meeting was to provide an official response to the Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy for a Notice of Application Received Re: Valentine Feeders Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application that was received by the Board on April 28, 2020.

Cherry County Zoning Administrator Jessica Coyle stated that Cherry County did not receive a Conditional Use Permit application for Valentine Feeders until the previous day, May 26, 2020. The application was received after Administrator Coyle had provided information to the Board during their regular meeting. The application will be forwarded to the Cherry County Planning Commission for their review and recommendation prior to consideration by the Board of Commissioners.

Ward moved and DeNaeyer seconded to respond to the NDEE that Cherry County just received the zoning application on May 26, 2020, and it will have to go through our Zoning and Planning Board, subject to public comment. Cherry County has no comment on Valentine Feeders Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation until our Zoning and Planning Board has studied, reviewed, and made recommendations to the Commissioners. Roll call vote: Ayes – Storer, DeNaeyer, Ward. The motion carried.

At 3:05 PM, with no further business to come before the Board, Chairman Storer declared the meeting adjourned.
