BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MINUTES SPECIAL MEETING November 16, 2021

The Cherry County Board of Commissioners convened in special session on November 16, 2021 in the Commissioners Meeting Room of the Cherry County Courthouse, as per notice posted on November 9, 2021 at the Cherry County Courthouse, Valentine Post Office, and Valentine Public Library, with the agenda being on file in the office of the County Clerk. The meeting was called to order at 3:06 PM by Chairman Storer. Roll call was taken. Present for the meeting were Cherry County Commissioners Tanya Storer, Martin DeNaeyer, James Ward, and Cherry County Clerk Brittny Petersen. The Open Meetings Act Poster was acknowledged by Chairman Storer and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Board met with Cherry County Attorney Eric Scott, Cherry County Highway Superintendent Lloyd Smith, Niobrara Valley Consultants Bridge Inspector, John Wietzke, and Gregg Perrett of Perrett Construction to discuss the recent closure and condition of Structure C001612610P (Mogle Bridge). Estimates for replacing or repairing the structure and timelines for bidding requirements and repairs were discussed. Storer moved and Ward seconded to table the agenda item regarding waiving bidding requirements of the County Purchasing Act if such waiver is necessary to meet an emergency which threatens serious loss of life, health, or property in the county as it pertains to Structure C001612610P pending a report from Gregg Perrett on a test pile. Roll call vote: Aye – Storer, DeNaeyer, Ward. The motion carried.

The Board met with Niobrara Valley Consultants Nebraska Registered Land Surveyor, Timothy Hanson, to review a Plat of Survey. Cherry County Attorney Eric Scott will clarify with the current owner of the lots being re-platted whether maintenance of the proposed right-of-way is expected by the county. Storer moved and Ward seconded to table the agenda item regarding Plat of Survey Approval and Acceptance – Replat of Lot 1 Spring Creek Addition in Sections 27 and 28, and Lots 3, 4, and 5, Spring Creek Addition in Section 21, T34N, R27W of the 6th P.M., Cherry County Nebraska until further notice from the developers. Roll call vote: Aye – DeNaeyer, Ward, Storer. The motion carried.

Ward moved and DeNaeyer seconded to approve health insurance claims. Roll call vote: Aye – Ward, Storer, DeNaeyer. The motion carried.
